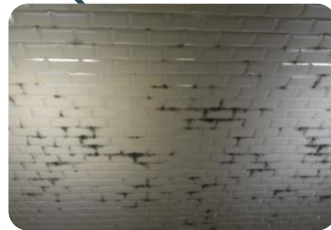

Fungal Detection through Volatil Organic Compounds (VOCs)



Emissions during growth phases



Construction of an index Incrementation as a function of the presence or absence of each target

- Detection of hidden contaminations (diffusion of VOC)
- Detection of recent contaminations (emission from the beginning of development)

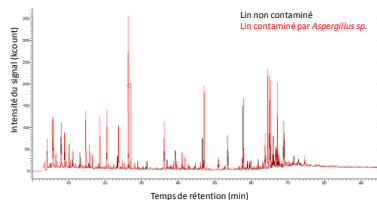

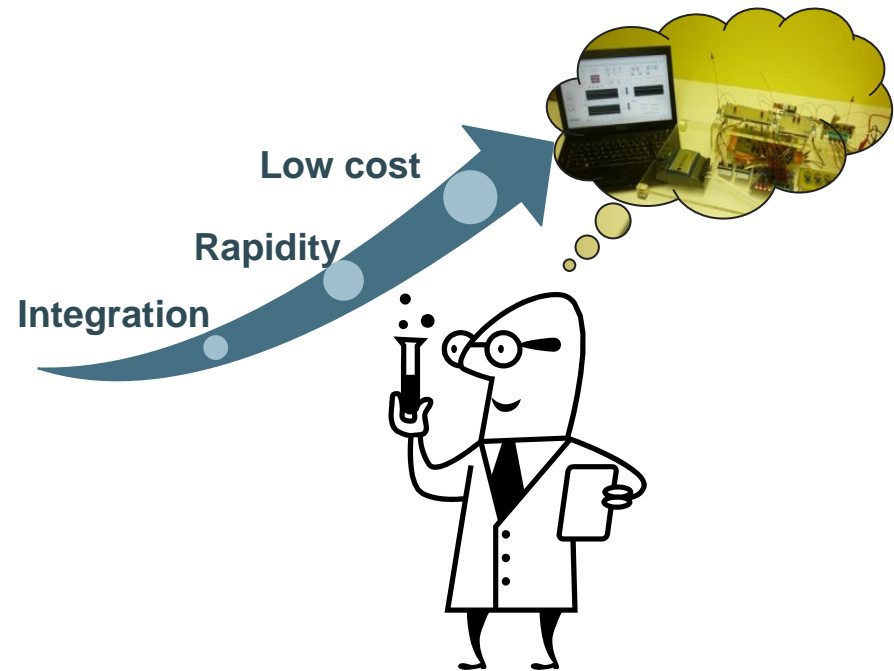
